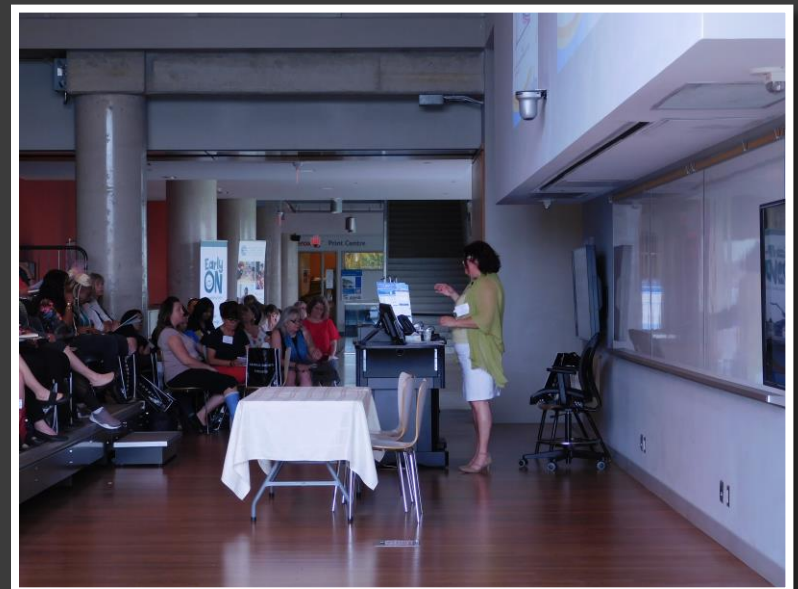

A Socio-Economic Analysis of Early Childhood Education and Care

This study documents the role of early childhood education in reducing income inequality. It recommends that governments provide a minimum of two years of preschool education for all children while improving program quality. Although governments have fiscal constraints, investments in ECE should be made a priority given their significant economic and social returns.

Highlights from the report:

- **ECE would allow another 76,000 mothers to work, lifting 23,000 families out of poverty**
- **To meet international standards Canada needs to provide ECE to almost 400,000 additional children age 2-5**
- **Every \$1 invested in ECE returns \$3.6 to the economy**
