### Transforming Canada-China Educational Relations: Significant Legacies and Future Challenges - Tsinghua University, May 2014.

This conference brought together leaders and scholars involved in cooperative linkages between Chinese and Canadian universities across the fields of agriculture, education, engineering, environment, marine sciences, medicine, management, law and minority cultures between 1982 and the early 21st century. Keynote speakers analysed the long-term contribution of these projects, which were supported by the Canadian International Development Agency and spanned a dynamic and important period in the socio-economic development of China as well as Canada. Concurrent papers illustrated ways in which the legacy of these projects stimulated ongoing cooperation between universities in Canada and China. Most keynote papers appear in <u>Canadian Universities in China's Transformation: An Untold Story</u>, published by McGill-Queens University Press in 2016. PowerPoints mounted under the names of Keynote speakers, provide detailed and vivid documentation of the history of collaboration in each field. Many concurrent papers are found in two issues of *Frontiers of Education in China* : <u>Canada-China educational cooperation</u> & <u>Multi-Culture & China's Minority Education</u>.


