

The Ethel Elizabeth (Mackenzie) Anderson Graduate Award in Adult Learning 2024-2025 Application Form

This award was established in 1998 by Professor Harvey Anderson in honour of Ethel Elizabeth Anderson. It will be awarded to one or more research stream graduate students in the Department of Leadership, Higher and Adult Education on the basis of financial need, research focus, and academic merit. Applicants must be pursuing research on how adults outside the normal educational stream acquire the basic literacy and related skills to achieve their education milestones.

Recipients must be registered students in good academic standing during the 2024-2025 academic year and must have a demonstrated financial need pursuant to the Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Funds (OSOTF) requirements. OSOTF awards are restricted to Ontario residents. At the discretion of the Awards Committee, the value of each award will vary depending on endowment income and the number of applicants.

Value: Based on the accrued annual income (approximately \$12,000) which can be divided among multiple recipients
