

Diversity and Feminism in Research Graduate Award 2024-2025 Application Form

To be awarded to one or more students in the Department of Leadership, Higher and Adult Education to attend scholarly conferences related to their research in diversity and/or women's studies in education, scheduled on or before August 31, 2025. Preference will be given to non-funded students on the basis of financial need. Secondary preference will be given to first time applicants.

Recipients must be registered students in good academic standing during the 2024-2025 academic year (at the time of application and the conference) and must have a demonstrated financial need based on the University's criteria.

Awarded funding can only be used for the conference listed on application, which must be scheduled on or before August 31, 2025. Funding cannot be transferred to another conference. Conference registration fees, transportation and accommodation costs are eligible for reimbursement. Meals are not eligible for reimbursement. Proof of attendance (e.g. attendance tag), original receipts (accommodation & transportation) and boarding passes will be required.

Value: Based on the accrued annual income (approximately \$2,000) which can be divided among multiple recipients
