

EDUROAM INSTRUCTIONS

1. Set up and test your computer or device at your home institution first to ensure they work before travelling to Western.
2. Once it is set up, you will have wireless access to any eduroam-enabled institution worldwide.

SETTING UP your device:

OPTION 1

For University of Toronto (U of T) students and faculty visiting Western

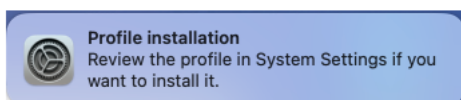
1. Before leaving U of T, check that your device can connect to the **eduroam** Wi-Fi network. If you are not connected to eduroam at UofT, you can download this installer: <https://cat.eduroam.org>
2. 2. At Western, log in to **eduroam** by entering [your UTORid]@utoronto.ca and your UTORid password.

The same should work for any other institution.

OPTION 2

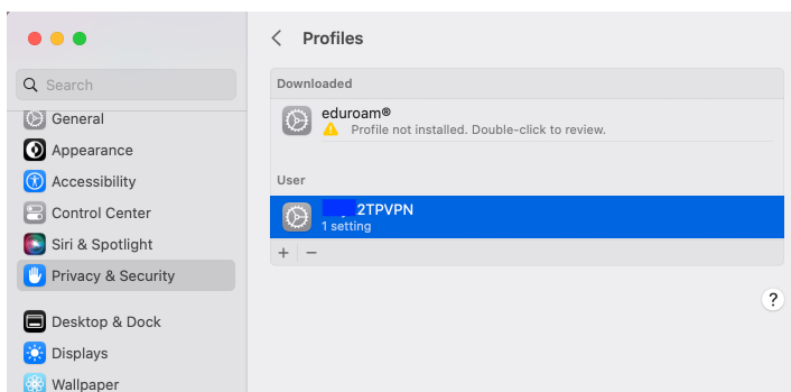
Eduroam Configuration Assistant tool: <https://eduroam.org/configuration-assistant-tool-cat/>

Click to download your eduroam installer in your device - Choose your home university

1. go to System Settings => Privacy and Security, scroll down until you see **Profiles**, it might be near the bottom.
